The grant of this permission/NOC is issued subject to
the following conditions: -


1. No pupil shall be refused admission on account of his caste, creed or religion and the pupil who has once been admitted shall not be treated differently from the other fellow pupils of his caste, creed or religion.
2. No pupil shall be compelled to attend a class in which a religious instruction is given or take part in any religious exercises.
3. The school with its account books, registers and other records shall be open to inspection at all reasonable hours by the authorised officer of the Deptt., Executive Officers of the Govt. authorised to inspect schools and Health Officer deputed by the Health Department to examine the Health of the student or sanitary conditions of the Building and premises.
4. The school shall have to furnish all information and returns as called for by the Department of Education from time to time.
5. The school shall comply with the rules of the Department and directions as given by the Department so far as they are applicable to private schools in the interest of maintaining standard. The Department of Education shall have the authority to send any of his officer for inspection for proper maintenance of educational standards, holidays as per state Govt. etc.
6. The private Institutions shall employ only the trained/eligible staff on the same pattern in which appointments are made in the Government Institutions in

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accordance with the R&F rules of each category and norms laid down by NCIE/NCERT.

7. No private institution shall function within the premises of existing Government institution.
8. Permission to run or establish a private Educational institution shall be granted only on individual basis and no permitted institution shall be entitled to open its branches elsewhere.
9. Admission in the institution shall be made strictly in accordance with the norms as laid down by the board of school Education to which the school is affiliated.
10. Teaching/Non Teaching staff shall be paid salary commensurate to the fees and funds to be charged from the students, donations and other sources of income of institution.
11. All the posts to be filled shall be advertised at least in two leading National daily newspapers or getting sponsorship of names from the nearest employment exchange giving full details of the qualifications required and scale of pay and allowances to be given.
12. Every private educational institution shall bring out prospectus giving full details of the management running the institutions, details of the staff their qualifications, fees, funds and donations to be charged from the students and other relevant information about the institution and shall also contain the permission of the govt. to establish and run the institution.
13. Proper record of the receipt books to be used for charging fees and funds and other income etc. shall be maintained properly.
14. All the members of the staff shall be paid their salaries and related arrears through Account payees bank cheques only.
15. Fees funds shall be such that they are not of exploiting nature but contribute to the spread of education. They should be commensurate to the salary of the staff being paid, development of infrastructure and facilities and activities being provided to the students.
16. Each private educational institution shall form Parent Teacher Association, the parents and Teachers being its members. It shall have its executive body with 2/3 members from amongst parents and 1/3 members from Teachers. It shall be of advisory nature and still strive for the better running of the institution and cordial relation between management parents and teachers.
17. Each Teacher shall be given workload in such a manner that it does not exceed 24 hours in a week in any case. In case of non teaching staff it shall be 7 hours (42 hours in a week).
18. The school staff and students shall not take part in any agitation directed against the authority of Govt. or disseminate opinions tending to excite feelings of disloyalty or disaffection against the Govt. or of enmity and hatred between different communities.

The breach of any of the conditions specified above shall render the school defaulter and the Department of education after conducting any enquiry through any of the officers so designed by him, shall have the power to cancel the permission to run/establish a private Educational Institute.
